Children will be placed in a safe environment with family, and families will have the necessary resources to care for the children.


## What We Do

In 2020, Boost a Foster Family provided over \$185,000 in items and services to kinship foster families throughout the State of Arizona.



# Who We Serve

**Boost a Foster Family** provides assistance to Kinship Foster Families with a financial need throughout Arizona.

Kinship Foster Families are relatives of children placed in foster care that are called upon unexpectedly to take in the children until they can be returned to their parents or become eligible for adoption.

1060 Families Served in 2020 (648 were over the age of 55)

3256 Total Children Served (includes birth children and foster children)
