






The seed that was planted in 2016 when Boost a Foster Family began, has flourished and grown in a deeply rooted belief that children will thrive and blossom when placed with kin.

Vision: Children will be placed in a safe environment with family (kin), and families will have the necessary resources to care for the children.


Boost a Foster Family was created to meet the needs of low-income kinship families applying for foster care licensure. We receive referrals from Arizona Department of Child Safety and Arizona





Prospective foster families will fulfill their state requirements and be granted licenses quicker, thus allowing them to begin receiving much needed resources only available to licensed caregivers.








Foster Children Served by Year





In 2023, Boost a Foster Family expects to serve over 1300 families impacting over 2,500 foster children with a increased budget of \$270,000. In response to this 10-15% growth, Boost a Foster Family is developing a Community Board of Directors to faciliate needed strategic planning.
